It is a high mark of distinction and recognition for arrowmen who, by the reason of exceptional service and unselfish interest, have made distinguished contributions beyond the immediate responsibilities of their position. To be eligible for consideration for the Vigil Honor, an arrowman must have been a Brotherhood member for at least two years at the time of the Lodge Vigil selection meeting; and a member in good standing with the Great Lakes Council, B.S.A. and the Migisi Opawgan lodge #162 (registered with dues paid).
