Here's how.

Step #1 – Select 1-2 possible troop meeting dates from your unit's calendar.

Step #2 – Be sure to allocate 30-35 minutes for the election that night.

Step #3 – Contact your facing Chapter Adviser to schedule the election.

Step #4 – Identify prior to election night all eligible candidates. Criteria:

- Approval of Scoutmaster
- Registered unit member
- First Class or higher
- 15 nights of camping, which includes a long-term camp of 6 days/5 nights

Step #5 – Reconfirm one week in advance of your scheduled election date.
